AMENDMENT #6 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN OLD LYME SHORES BEACH ASSOCIATION WPCA AND FUSS & O'NEILL, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

Witnesseth, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties hereto agree to amend their Agreement dated May 16, 2013 as follows:

Whereas, the OLSBA WPCA (the Owner) continues to proceed with the permitting, design, bidding, and construction of facilities to provide stormwater and public sewering utilities as described in the approved wastewater facilities plan CWF # 644-PG dated March 13, 2013 (hereinafter referred to as the Project) and in compliance support of the Unified Consent Order CO WRMU18001 issued by CTDEEP on February 14, 2018; and

Whereas, the Owner understands that construction administration and resident representative services previously included within the original agreement scope of work have now been budgeted; and,

Whereas, the Owner understands that future services to provide negotiating assistance with Intermunicipal Agreements and the Cost Sharing Agreement will be reimbursed by the Town of Old Lyme under a separate proposal addressed Cost Sharing Agreement members.

Whereas, the Owner has adequate funding available within their overall project budget for the project to finance these engineering services herein; now,

WITNESSETH, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties hereto agree, each with each other, as follows:

ARTICLE 2 – SCOPE OF SERVICES

Section 2.11.2 – Add the following paragraph:

Future services to provide negotiating assistance to modify the original Intermunicipal Agreements between the Cost Sharing Agreement Members and the Town of East Lyme and City of New London to add wastewater flows generated by the Town-controlled Soundview Association and Miscellaneous Area B, the Cost Sharing Agreement, and the Agreement to add the Town to the Cost Sharing Agreement is not included in this scope of services. This additional scope of services shall be captured and reimbursed by the Town of Old Lyme under a separate proposal addressed to the Cost Sharing Agreement members.

Section 2.14 – Add the following paragraphs:

2.14.11 Review and recommend approval of payment requisitions from the Prime Contractor. Engineer shall also assist the Owner in preparing and submitting materials for reimbursement

through the Clean Water Fund being obtained from the State of Connecticut.

2.14.12 Process Requests for Information (RFI) submitted by the Contractor and issue Work Change Directives and Field Orders, as necessary. RFIs requiring significant engineering evaluation will be discussed with the Owner for approval prior to responding to the RFI request.

2.14.13 Review Contractor's claims for extra work and respond accordingly. If the additional work is justified, the Engineer will prepare a Change Order.

ARTICLE 4 - PERIOD OF SERVICE

Section 4.1 - Modify the paragraph **in bold** as follows:

The Engineer shall proceed with the services under this Agreement promptly and will diligently and faithfully prosecute the work to completion in accordance with applicable engineering standards subject to any delays due to strikes, action of the elements, act of any government, civil disturbances, issues with downstream wastewater transport or treatment facilities or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Engineer. The schedule for completion of the scope of services provided herein is approximately Fall 2022 contingent upon timely authorization of the scope of services provided in Section 2 herein and project permitting.

ARTICLE 5 – PAYMENT TO THE ENGINEER

Payments for the Resident Representative will be based on an indirect cost rate of 167.95 162.18 percent of direct salaries and wages. This rate is subject to annual adjustment as determined by audit and approved by the State of Connecticut.

Section 5.3.3.3 – Revise paragraph as follows: Direct costs include such typical expenses as cost of: transportation, long-distance telephone and telegraph; printing and reproduction; computer time and programming costs; identifiable supplies; outside consultant's charges; subcontracts for services such as testing by commercial laboratories; and charges by reviewing authorities. Automobile mileage will be charged at the IRS approved rate (currently \$0.545 \$0.575 per mile).
