PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our July 4th activities were outstanding and better than ever, thanks to Julia and Margaret. The parade had more family floats than I remember and a lot of thought and work went into them. The beach activities, pizza and ice cream trucks were a huge success, as well as the DJ - and the return of Michael Cleary to the Brightwater Stage on July 18th.

This 4th was the most crowded I've ever seen here at OLS. Hardly a space on the beach and the weather was perfect. While the sun was shining, our residents and guests were well behaved and respectful of their neighbors. Our beach staff, led by Erik Bird had only a few educational moments with folks who had coolers, food or alcohol on the beach. They were backed up by supportive OLS residents!

We were proactive this year and worked with Edge Lea and Old Colony to coordinate the security of our property, keeping public safety our priority on the evening of the 4th. At Sheffield Brook, we set up two fence lines and informed those crossing that OLS is a private property and that the beach was closed. This worked for temporarily, until large numbers of young people pushed through our security line or hopped the fence in front of Mark Phelan's house. Myself, Rob Cappellucci, our 2 private security guards and other OLS residents were unable to stop this influx. The police responded quickly and broke up a large crowd between Sea Spray and Saltaire which created a problem at Old Colony when they ran from our beach to theirs. Next year, we'll continue working with the Town as well as the other beaches to address these issues.

We're all fortunate to have to ability to vacation or live here at Old Lyme Shores and we all have the responsibility to work to make our association better, safer and more family friendly.

Neighborhood Safety + Security

- Evening/night security company on weekends
- Beach & Gate Attendants (Erik Bird Lead)
- Road Closure Schedule 1 Gate Open Weekends
- Speed Gates placed on roads, including Bellaire Road
- Radar signs are operational on all 4 streets

Beach + Gate Priorities

- Attendants ensure all guests are properly vetted before entering Old Lyme Shores and a log kept of guests.
- Safe driving within 15 MPH speed limit ALL residents of Old Lyme Shores have a stake in this.
- Friday evening beach movies and weekday REC programs will be posted on OLS Bulletin boards, Website, and Facebook page.
