Dear Friends:

Hoping your summer season at OLSBA is going well. I am pleased to offer this personal update on the WPCA & our community's sewer/stormwater project.

1. Congratulations to Chris Sheldon upon his reappointment to the WPCA for a 3 year term commencing July 1, 2026. Chris has been a valued member of the WPCA and we appreciate his willingness to accept a new term.

The WPCA also received a letter of resignation from Martin Merritt. The WPCA is, of course, most appreciative of Marty's interest & involvement.

As I write this update the WPCA, presently has two vacancies.

2. On 7/27/26, there was a site visit by our engineering firm (F&O) and contractor (Baltazar). While actual construction of the internal sewer/stormwater infrastructure is not anticipated to commence before mid-September 2026, some preparatory work in August, 2026 is required including the moving of our Gorton Avenue storage shed to another location on the site in preparation for the construction of the Bioxide Facility, tree trimming and well testing. More information regarding the planned tree trimming & well testing will be provided soon.

3. On July 14, 2026, the WPCA hosted a joint meeting with the BOG & Association Officers at the OL Town Hall to discuss the sewer/stormwater project and coordination of efforts.

4. The WPCA will soon schedule a public hearing, required by state statute, to provide an update to the community regarding the project and its timetable, prior to the commencement of actual construction

5. The next scheduled WPCA meeting is planned to be held on August 11, 2026.
